2. Council approved Minutes from March 10, 2014 Regular Council Meeting.

Council voted to approve the preliminary layout for the Patriot Hall with a few changes from the Council: walls outside bathrooms and kitchen that are not load bearing could be removed, put baby changing stations, hand-dryers, and counter tops around the sinks in the bathrooms, dressing rooms off stage with sliding doors and mirrors with counter tops for putting on makeup. On the outside put awnings over the end doors, and consider putting siding on the building to cover the windows which are odd shapes and locations.
4. Council approved the final reading of Ordinance 2014-0324, Zoning Procedures & Standards.
5. Council ratified the three members named to the Ethics Board.
6. Council voted to put Mission Statement on hold until the Council has a chance to discuss it at a Work Session.
