1. Council approved Minutes from October 27, 2014 Work Session.
2. Council approved Minutes from October 27, 2014 Public Hearing Meeting.
3. Council approved Minutes from October 27, 2014 Regular Council Meeting.
4. Council approved Correction to October 13, 2014 Minutes
5. Council voted to approve ratifying the approval of the Citizen's Park Redesign Agreement with CPL in the amount of \$6,500.00.
6. Council approved the Scheme "A" from the Citizen's Park redesign alternatives presented by John Anderson of Anderson Design.
7. Council voted to approve the Resolution of support for a traffic signal on St. Rt. 2 at S. Chapman Road.
8. Council approved awarding Viking Engineering and Construction Mgt, LLC's bid in the amount of \$38,600.00 to perform repairs to the Water Treatment Plant Clearwell.
9. Council voted to approve the City renting a track hoe approximately in the amount of \$3,000.00 per month in order to start the sewer line in the Candy Lane Extension Project.
10. Council approved the annual contract renewal between the City of Ringgold and Catoosa Citizens for Literacy for 2014-2015 in the amount of \$2,500.00.
11. Council voted to allow Mayor Barger to proceed with his request to Jeff Mullis to pass resolution in honor of Pvt. Lonnie S. Rhinehart and to have discussions with the County to name a road after him. First choice would be Graysville Rd. and Hwy 41 intersection; the second choice would be Battlefield Parkway and Hwy 41 intersection.
12. Council approved the new application for employee health coverage to GMEBS Life and Health Program.
13. Council voted to approve the introduction of an Ordinance for participation in the GMEBS Life and Health Program.

14. Council approved the introduction of an ordinance Visual and Sound Recordings, which would allow recordings at all public meetings.
15. Council approved the Proposed Budget 2015 as presented.
16. Council voted to approve the Capital Improvement Project List.
17. Council voted to discontinue curb stop garbage service on Herb Fry Drive and to give residents a 30-day notice and have residents bring their garbage to Hwy 41. The location will be designated by Mike Cagle of Public Works.
18. Council approved a new telemetry system from Wilson Control Services in the amount of \$10,900.00 with a recurring monthly cost for each RTU (remote transmitting unit) for a total of two RTUs.
