

TextMyGov: A New Way to Stay Informed

The new service, TextMyGov, allows users to ask questions like "When is trash pick up?" or to report problems like potholes, broken street lamps, and more by simply texting "Hi" to 706–222–3443. Another feature is the ability to receive alerts about upcoming events by texting "RNG EVENTS" to 91896 and other vital updates like road closures by texting "RNG ALERTS" to the same number. 


Free Films & Family Fun

Summer Movie Series Returns to Ringgold


