The building boasts five built-to-suit spaces for small businesses, public restrooms, and an outdoor community area with a fireplace, seating, string lights, and yard games. Benton's first set of tenants are Book & Barrel, a store that will offer a diverse selection of wine and books with the goal of connection and education, and 810 Butcher Shoppe & Deli, a business focused on finding quality locally sourced products, including meats, cheeses, jams, sandwiches, and more.
