# 1890 Days' 50 Year Birthday Bash!

In 1975, two Ringgold women, Betty Land and Juanita Caldwell, wanted to create a festival for their community after being inspired by the Gold Rush Days Festival in Dahlonega. They set their event apart by having participants dress in 1890s-era attire, and the 1890 Days Jamboree was born! Years later, the Jamboree is now a staple in our community, and people from all over travel to Ringgold to celebrate Memorial Day weekend. Turning fifty is a big deal, so the Jamboree is pulling out all the stops to commemorate the occasion. The weekend begins with a Gospel night on Fri, May 23rd, from 5:30 pm to 10 pm, and continues on Sat, the 24th, from 9 am to 10 pm, with live music, vendors, a parade, vintage baseball, Depot Dash 5k, and more.
